This is a knitting pattern for a small, tiny preemie, newborn, or 3-month-old baby bonnet. The bonnet is knit in the round on two needles and features a ribbed brim and a cute little earflap design. The pattern is easy to follow and includes step-by-step instructions and photos. The finished bonnet is approximately 12 inches in circumference and 6 inches deep.

Materials:

- Approximately 50 yards of worsted weight yarn
- Size 8 (5mm) knitting needles
- Tapestry needle

Gauge:

4 stitches per inch in stockinette stitch

Finished Size:

Approximately 12 inches in circumference and 6 inches deep

Skill Level:

Easy

Pattern Instructions:**Ribbed Brim:**

1. Cast on 90 stitches.
2. Knit 2, purl 2 around for 10 rows.

Body:

3. Knit in the round without ribbing for 30 rounds.

Earflaps:

4. Divide the stitches into three equal sections of 30 stitches each.
5. Place a marker at the beginning of each section.
6. Knit across the first section, then place the stitches on hold on a cable needle.

7. Knit across the second section, then place the stitches on hold on a cable needle.
8. Knit across the third section, then join the stitches from the cable needles.
9. Knit 5 more rounds without dividing the stitches.

Decrease Rows:

10. **Round 1:** Knit 2, knit 2 together, repeat around.
11. **Round 2:** Knit around.
12. **Rounds 3-5:** Repeat Rounds 1 and 2.

Bind Off:

16. Knit 2 together around until there are only 6 stitches remaining.
17. Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail.
18. Thread the tail through the remaining stitches and pull tight to close the bonnet.

Finishing:

Weave in any loose ends and block the bonnet to shape.

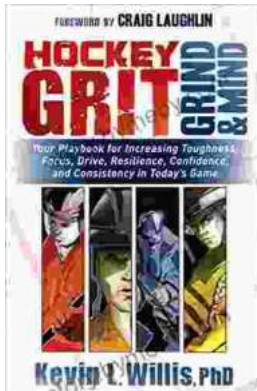

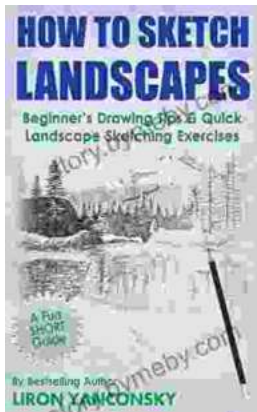
