#### **Dress**

#### **Back**

Cast on 80 stitches.

Row 1: K all stitches.

Row 2: P all stitches.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until the piece measures 25cm from the cast-on edge.

### Front

Cast on 80 stitches.

Row 1: K all stitches.

Row 2: P all stitches.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until the piece measures 23cm from the cast-on edge.

Shape the neckline:

Row 1: K 10, cast off 2, k to the end of the row.

Row 2: P all stitches.

Row 3: K 10, cast off 1, k to the end of the row.

Row 4: P all stitches.

Row 5: K 10, cast off 1, k to the end of the row.

Row 6: P all stitches.

Row 7: K to the end of the row.

Repeat Rows 2-7 until the piece measures 25cm from the cast-on edge.

# **Assembly**

Sew the shoulder seams together.

Sew the side seams together, leaving a 10cm opening for the armholes.

# Apron

Cast on 40 stitches.

Row 1: K all stitches.

Row 2: P all stitches.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until the piece measures 20cm from the cast-on edge.

Tie strings:

Cast on 20 stitches.

Row 1: K all stitches.

Row 2: P all stitches.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until the piece measures 50cm from the cast-on edge.

Sew the tie strings to the top of the apron.

#### Headscarf

Cast on 100 stitches.

Row 1: K all stitches.

Row 2: P all stitches.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until the piece measures 20cm from the cast-on edge.

Shape the scarf:

Row 1: K 10, cast off 2, k to the end of the row.

Row 2: P all stitches.

Row 3: K 10, cast off 1, k to the end of the row.

Row 4: P all stitches.

Row 5: K 10, cast off 1, k to the end of the row.

Row 6: P all stitches.

Row 7: K to the end of the row.

Repeat Rows 2-7 until the piece measures 25cm from the cast-on edge.

# Shoes

# Sole

Cast on 10 stitches.

Row 1: K all stitches.

Row 2: P all stitches.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until the piece measures 5cm from the cast-on edge.

Shape the sole:

Row 1: K 5, cast off 2, k to the end of the row.

Row 2: P all stitches.

Row 3: K 5, cast off 1, k to the end of the row.

Row 4: P all stitches.

Row 5: K 5, cast off 1, k to the end of the row.

Row 6: P all stitches.

Row 7: K to the end of the row.

Repeat Rows 2-7 until the piece measures 7cm from the cast-on edge.

# **Upper**

Cast on 12 stitches.

Row 1: K all stitches.

Row 2: P all stitches.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until the piece measures 5cm from the cast-on edge.

Shape the upper:

Row 1: K 5, cast off 2, k to the end of the row.

Row 2: P all stitches.

Row 3: K 5, cast off 1, k to the end of the row.

Row 4: P all stitches.

Row 5: K 5, cast off 1, k to the end of the row.

Row 6: P all stitches.

Row 7: K to the end of the



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
